## How to Request Permission

For previously published materializect your request for grant permission to the permissions department of the journal or publiss. For unpublished material, contance creator of the work to find out who owns the copyright. Request permissions as possible. In the event that your request cannot be granted, you will need timesubstitute other material.

Include all of the following information in your request (see attached form):
